Subject: Grant of Recognition as an Awarding Body to Automotive Skills Development Council (ASDC) by NCVET for a period of Three (03) continuous years effective from 08/06/2022 - Reg.

- 1. NCVET by the virtue of functions and powers entrusted by gazette notification No. SD-17/113/2017-E&PW dated 05th December, 2018 under Section 16(1) (a) grants recognition to **Automotive Skills Development Council (ASDC)** to function as an Awarding Body for the territorial jurisdiction allocated by NCVET for its NSQF aligned & approved qualifications either developed or adopted by the AB.
- 2. Based on the information provided by the Awarding Body to meet the criteria as per the Guidelines for Recognition and Regulation of Awarding Bodies (AB) 2020 (referred to as AB Guidelines) & Operational Manual, **Automotive Skills Development Council (ASDC)** has entered into an Agreement with NCVET on **08/06/2022** for the grant of recognition as an Awarding Body for a period of 3 continuous years applicable from the date of signing of Agreement subject to satisfactory performance, based on the continuation criteria and provisions of the risk ratings as specified in section 4 of the AB Guidelines. The recognition has been granted to **Automotive Skills Development Council (ASDC)** for the following territorial jurisdiction and qualification(s):
 - 2.1 Territorial Jurisdiction for which recognition is granted:

PAN India

- 2.2 NSQF aligned & approved qualifications either developed or adopted by the AB and as updated on National Qualification Register (NQR) from time to time.
- 3. Further, in accordance with the provisions of the Agreement, Automotive Skills Development Council (ASDC) is authorized to discharge its functions, responsibilities and obligations of an Awarding Body in the allocated territorial jurisdiction for its NSQF aligned & approved qualifications either developed or adopted by the Awarding Body. The NCVET

recognized Awarding Body can award NCVET certificate to trainees/ learners after successful completion of training and assessment for its NSQF aligned & approved qualifications either developed or adopted by the Awarding Body. The Awarding Body is *inter-alia* authorized to carry out the following functions:

- 3.1 Conform to the recommendations/ conditions for empanelment of training bodies as prescribed in section 4 of the AB Guidelines and clause 7 of the Agreement.
- 3.2 Affiliate training bodies for imparting vocational training including skilling, reskilling and recognition of prior learning with up-skilling, apprenticeship training in accordance with the Agreement.
- 3.3 Ensure on-boarding of Assessment Agency/ Agencies from the NCVET recognized pool of AAs subject to clause 7.1.13 listed in the Agreement.
- 3.4 Develop and submit new/ revised qualifications to NCVET for its necessary approval. The AB shall ensure that the review of qualifications is undertaken well before the expiry of the same as per the NCVET qualification approval mechanism/ guidelines from time to time.

4. The Awarding Body shall be governed by the terms and conditions of the Agreement, AB Guidelines, AA Guidelines, and the respective Operational Manuals.
